Payment Options

The YMCA offers the following three payments of membership fees:

Bank Draft Payment

This option is designed to be a more convenient and easy way to pay month to month, directly from your checking or savings account on the 10th or 21st. Requires payment of pro-rated monthly dues, and joining fee at time of enrollment.

Annual Payment

This option is perfect for those members who desire to pay for their membership one year at a time. Requires payment of 12 months fees and joining fee.

Corporate Payment

This option is for our corporate clients. Your monthly dues will be payroll deducted through employers offering payroll deduction, bank draft, or annual.

- Each additional young-adult 1/2 price \$14.00/Mo
- Each additional youth 1/2 price \$8.00/Mo
